The visit to the Yi Jun Peace Museum will last from 17:30 to 18:30. The Museum is one of Koreas' most important heritage sites for Yi Jun outside of the peninsula. The privately run museum is installed the former Hotel De Jong where Korean diplomat Yi Jun briefly resided during the Second Hague Peace Conference (1907) to which the delegation failed to be admitted. Bertha von Suttner and William Stead (Courrier de la Conference) defended the cause of the Korean eminssionaries, providing opportunities to publicise their cause to the world.
